



This ancient and small lighthouse was built in 1879, on the northern end of the breakwater, after the sinking of a sailing vessel which in the storm failed to overcome the pier, ending up against the rocks. It was built right on the ancient Bourbon pier of which it represents the only remnant.

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The St Thomas Newport Minster

The church is at the heart of Newport and it was given the name in 1175 and it has been there for over 800 years. In 1854 the church was rebuild and Prince Albert laid a foundation stone that dedicated the church jointly to both saint and we now have a Minster that proudly goes by the name of St Thomes



St Thomas was dedicated a Minister at Easter 2008. During 2007 Newport Minster has been involved in setting up a new island trail which the trail links to Carisbrook Castle, Osborne and St Mildreds Church

Largo dos Aviadores

On April 30, 1927, the monument commemorating the voyage of Gago Coutinho and Sacadura Cabral was inaugurated

Also known as Largo Sacadura Cabral, where the monument in honor of the aviators Gago Coutinho and Sacadura Cabral is located, commemorating the famous first aerial crossing of the Atlantic in 1922,



using navigation instruments such as the precision sextant and the course corrector of his invention.

The Hunters Monument

The Hunters Monument, which is the first monument dedicated to the soldiers who fought in the 1877 war. The name of the statue comes from the military unit that participated in the campaign, the 2nd Hunters Battalion from Ploiesti.

In order to honor their heroism in the Independence War, in 1880 appears the initiative to build a monument dedicated to them. In the span of 7 years, more than 20.000 have donated to the fundraiser.

The unveiling of the monument took place on the 12th of October 1897 and was inaugurated by the ruler of the time, King Charles the first.

The project consists of a granite obelisk and 4 bronze sculptures of Prahova soldiers. On the 4 sides of the obelisk were mounted 4 plaques: the first one, showing the hunters' assault on the Grivita redoubt, the 2nd one is an allegory of the goddess Victoria in the midst of people.



The 3rd one represented the inauguration event and on the 4th one were written the names of the people who donated for the construction. The last two plaques were later replaced with plaques depicting Kind Charles the First and Queen Elisabeth.

Basilica of Santa Maria

The church is dedicated to the Madonna, who appeared here on the 3rd of April 1490 before the eyes of Caterina degli Uberti, her vision triggered great popular devotion. The virgin, who appeared to Caterina, answered her request and allowed her to be rescued. Behind the eighteenth-century marble altar there are two dressed wooden statues, depicting the Virgin and Catherine of the Uberti.
